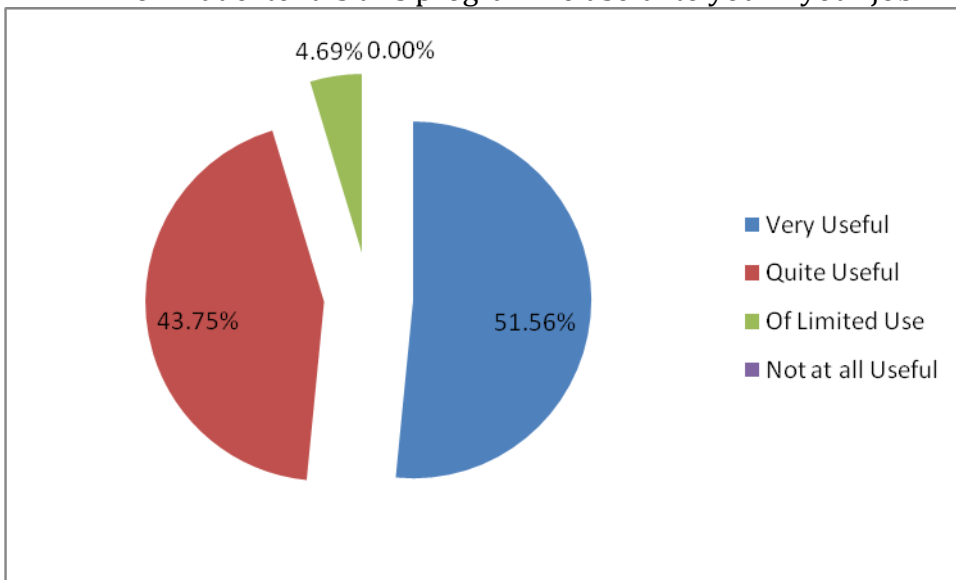

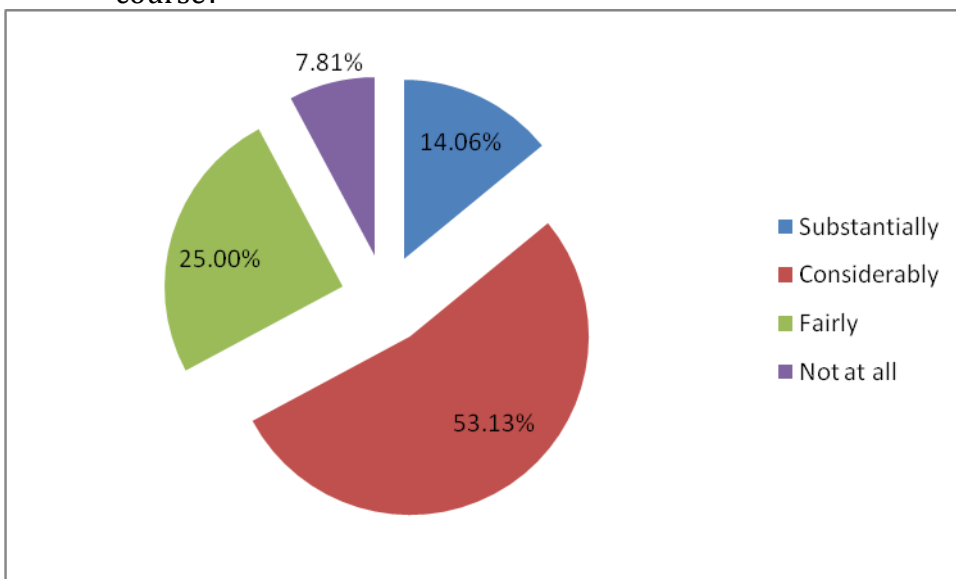

A total of 73 participants attended (List Attached – Annexure I). Out of the feedback obtained from them, the following graphs show the achieved results for the programme.

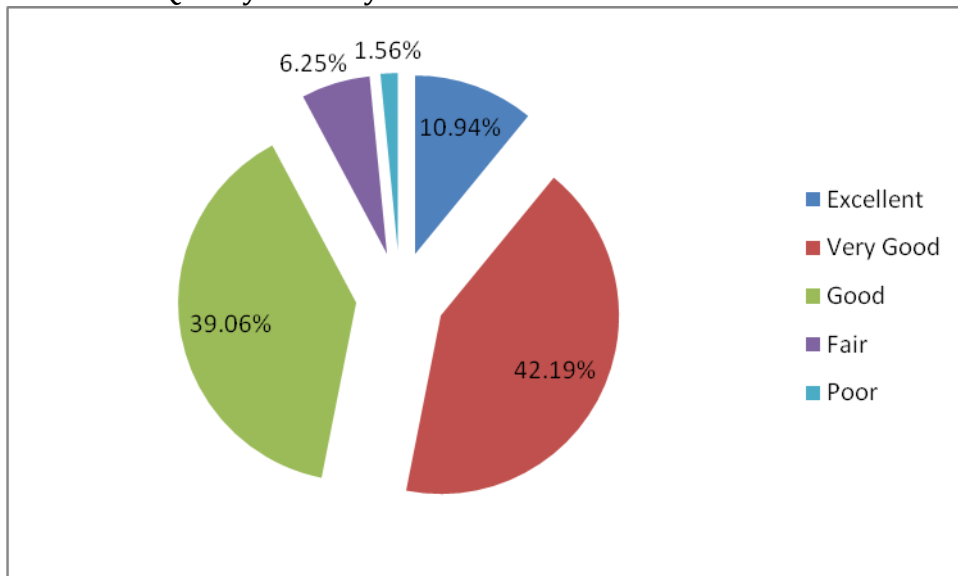
1. To what extent is this programme useful to you in your job?



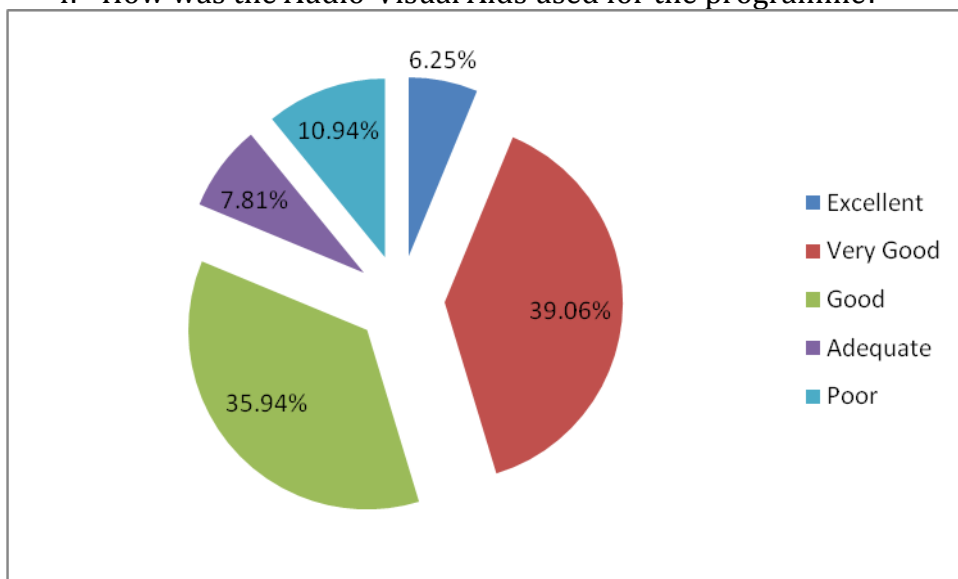
2. How far have you been benefitted from interaction with the fellow participants in the course?



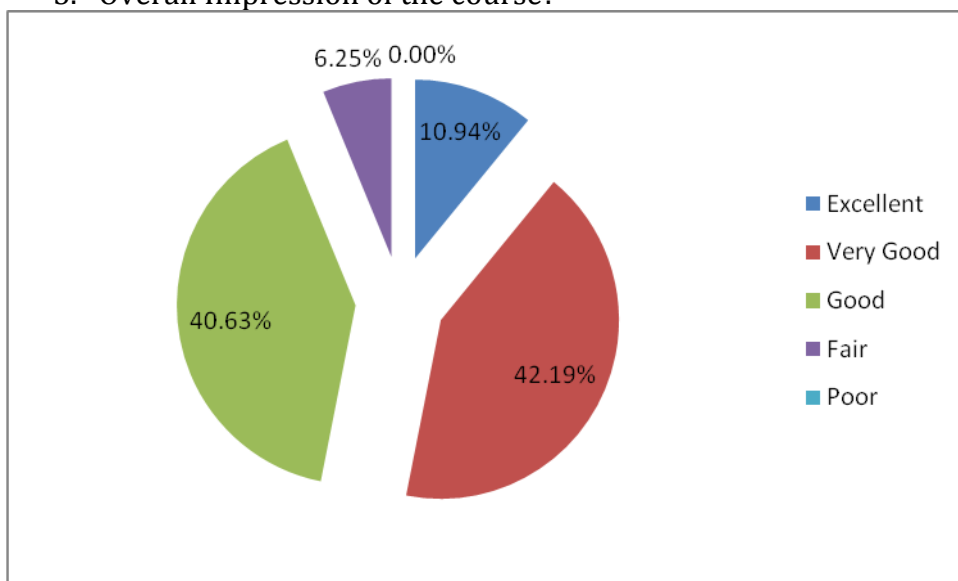
### 3. The Quality & Utility of the course material?
