

1. ABOUT NPC

The National Productivity Council (NPC) is an autonomous body operating under the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Government of India. India has introduced new environment, social, and governance (ESG) reporting requirements for the top 1,000 listed companies in the country by market capitalization. Hence, the purpose of this program is to sensitize participants on the aspects of Sustainability and Business Responsibility and Sustainability Report (BRSR). Environmental issues may include corporate climate policies, energy use, waste, pollution, natural resource conservation, and treatment of animals. ESG considerations can also help evaluate any environmental risks a company might face and how the company is managing those risks. Consideration may include direct and indirect greenhouse gas emissions, management of toxic waste, and compliance with environmental regulations. For measuring, monitoring and disclosing performance in areas related to ESG, Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) has mandated the sustainability disclosure requirements vide its circular no 18/2021, dated 10th May 2021. Under this Business Responsibility and Sustainability Reporting (BRSR) shall be applicable to the top 1000 listed entities (by Market Capitalization) from FY 2022-23. The BRSR framework has been revised with Core KPIs and glide path for BRSR Core reasonable assurance as per SEBI circular dated 12 July 2023.
