

1. ABOUT NPC

GeM portal (Government e-Marketplace) is an online portal launched by the Government of India for procurement of Goods and Services by various Ministries / Departments of Central & State Government organizations, public sector undertaking etc. Govt. of India has made necessary amendments in the GFR 2017 vide rule 149 for mandatory procurement through GeM. The main aim of introducing GeM portal is to enhance transparency, efficiency speed and effectiveness in public procurement.
