

1. ABOUT NPC

Together, these sectors shape India's climate trajectory and highlight the need for a coordinated, economy-wide transition.

This programme aims to build awareness among stakeholders about the concept of net-zero and its relevance to India's long-term development. It will focus on sector-specific and cross-sectoral strategies, sustainable technologies, and enabling policy frameworks that can reduce emissions while enhancing productivity, competitiveness, and resilience. Key concerns—ranging from methane and nitrous oxide emissions in agriculture, to fossil fuel dependence in industry and transport, to inefficient resource use—underscore the need for integrated climate action. India has already launched major initiatives such as renewable energy expansion, electric mobility, cleaner industrial technologies, organic and natural farming, and digital solutions for efficiency gains. The role of research institutions, industry bodies, farmer cooperatives, transport planners, and private investment will be critical in driving scalable change.

This programme will highlight practical pathways, tools, and collaborative models needed for India's multi-sector transition to net-zero, ensuring that economic growth is aligned with environmental responsibility, social equity, and long-term national resilience.
