About the webinar:

Behaviour Based Safety (BBS) is an established method of using positive reinforcement to change unsafe individual behaviour and to reinforce safe behaviour. BBS is the "application of science of behaviour change to real world safety problems". It is a process that creates a safety partnership between the management and the employees. **BBS** has been established as a way to increase control and manageability of safety culture in industrial setting. BBS strives to focus workers' attention on their own and their peers' daily safety behaviour, by focusing on what people do, analyzing why they do it and then applying a research-supported intervention strategy to do away with "unsafe acts". BBS mandates that management and employees alike consistently focus attention and action on their own daily behaviour to keep the facilities safe.
