PROGRAM OBJECTIVE:

The training program on "Good Governance& RTI" intends to provide insight about various provisions of RTI Act while addressing issues for making a citizen centric governance. The training would also identify opportunities for improvement in the process, systems and ensure quality in public service delivery. It's also intended to establish accountability and readiness in the process of delivering service to citizens as part of requirement under RTI Act-2005. The programme also aims to infuse awareness about access to information which is a toll to empower citizens in a democracy as it urges the people of the nation to scrutinize the actions and policies of the government.
